Parents at our WEEKLY FAMILY ENGAGEMENT PROGRAM aligned with Pūnana Leo schools curriculum, focusing on language, education and hands-on activities.

Me ke kāko‘o o nā ‘ohana a me ke kaiāulu, ua puka ke kānāwai hou e kāko‘o i ke ala ho‘ona‘auao keiki ma nā ‘ōlelo ‘elua kūhelu o Hawai‘i nei.

Through the support of our families and communities, a new State law established that early learning occurs in either of Hawai‘i’s two official languages, thus supporting our Pūnana Leo families.
